Electric diffuser with insecticide and mosquito repellent refill.

Description:

Electric diffuser with insecticide and mosquito repellent refill based on prallethrin. The dispenser with an on/off button is also suitable for use with insecticide tablets.

Method of use:

The bottle is fitted with a safety cap. To open, press the cap down and simultaneously unscrew it. After removing the protective cap, screw the bottle into the vaporizer's socket. Do not force the bottle, but screw it firmly.

Plug the vaporizer into a 230 V socket.

The plug can be rotated to fit the socket according to the orientation of the holes.

Ensure that the bottle is always in an upright position.

If you wish to stop the unit, simply unplug it.

If the vaporizer is not used for a long period of time, remove the bottle and screw the protective cap back on.

To replace the bottle, unscrew it firmly in the opposite direction to the initial insertion, in order to overcome the initial resistance.

To clean the vaporizer (once it has been switched off) use a dry cloth or kitchen roll.

Lasts 45 nights if switched on about 6-8 hours per night.
